

**Morehead State University**  
**Dual Credit Guidelines 2020FA**  
**Montgomery County High School/ MSU Mt. Sterling**

1. College courses will follow the Morehead State University guidelines on course delivery and calendar.
2. Courses will have increased academic rigor and are designed to demonstrate mastery of university content.
3. Students must follow guidelines within the course syllabus and given by the professor that address assignment deadlines and method of submission.
4. Students will need to follow guidelines with the Morehead State University Student Handbook as well as meet the guidelines established by Montgomery County Schools.
5. Students can use the KY Dual Credit Scholarship for classes at MSU Mt. Sterling. If students have already used the 2 KY Dual Credit Scholarships, the classes with MSU faculty will cost \$216 per course.
6. Students will need to familiar with the course Blackboard shell as well as their MSU email accounts. Changes to course meetings and university communications will come in these methods.
7. Make sure that you have appropriate face masks ready for classes and at the MSU at Mt. Sterling campus. Your course instructors will be requiring masks and should you not have one it may cause an attendance problem for you that day. Should you feel that you have a barrier or health condition that would prevent you from wearing a face mask, you will need to have documentation for an accommodation from the school district.
