Northview Elementary is located in Mount Sterling, Kentucky. It is one of four elementary schools in Montgomery County. Northview Elementary is a Pre-K through 5th grade school. Northview Elementary student population is currently 623 enrolled students. Minority students comprise 11% of the student enrollment, 18 students are English language learners with 139 students who receive special education services. Our current eligibility for free/reduced lunch percentage is 58.38%.

Our instructional blueprint implemented for the 2022-2023 school year includes a sequenced lesson with a clear learning objective, anticipatory set, teaching and modeling, guided practice with checks for understanding and independent practice, with an ending reflection time. Our schoolwide expectations prioritize safety, responsibility and respect within all learning environments.

Notable Achievements and Areas of Improvement

Our school has recently adopted the Fountas and Pinnell Classroom curriculum to support English/Language Arts instruction within our school. Our district as a whole is in the process of curriculum selection for math, science and social studies contents. This will allow for a focus on a viable curriculum to deliver instruction for each student at Northview Elementary. KSA data informs instructional practices and continues to show

decreased performance in the area of mathematics. We will continue to assess student performance throughout the school year using Case 21 (3x per year), MAP Benchmarks (3x per year), Brigance (incoming Kindergarten students), IOWA and COGAT (to identify gifted students in 3rd grade).
