Interim Assessments

(District Level)

Professionally created tests that address state standards. These assessments are given from one to three times a year to measure sstudent growth. (MAP)

Common Assessments (School Level)

Created by teacher teams and given to students to monitor student progress at the end of each unit.

These assessments are congrurent with state standards.

Scores will be analyzed in PLC's and shared with students.

Formative Assessments (Classroom Level)

Created by individual and/or grade level teachers and given to students on a daily basis. Results from these are used to determine the needs of every student and to drive instruction. These assessments specifically address specific learning targets taught in the classroom.

Response to Intervention

Tier 1 is for every student in a *general education* setting. (Classroom/School level assessments)

Tier 2 offers support in addition to the core instructional program.

Tier 3 offers a high level of instructional intensity.

Common Assessments (School Level): (End of Unit tests, Semester Exams)

Formative Assessements (Classroom Level): (Exit Slips, Learning Target Checks, Quizzes, etc.)

Response to Intervention: (DRA, AIMSWeb, Easy CBM, etc)
