## Countywide Internet Access Program

As we prepare for the school year to begin on August 31 starting with My MoCo Online and distance learning at home, we have been pursuing a plan to provide wireless internet service “hotspots” across the county.

We are thankful for our community partners committing to our students and being access points for WiFi. The locations were selected to extend Internet connectivity to parking lots in areas of the county where students might not have access to WiFi. In addition to certain areas in the parking lot at each of our schools, access points will be available at the following locations:

- Jeffersonville Assembly of God Church, 7220 Main Street, Jeffersonville
- Spruce Church of God, 4755 KY Highway 213, Jeffersonville
- Levee Fire Station, 7945 Levee Road, Jeffersonville
- Gateway Christian Church, 801 Winchester Road, Mt. Sterling
- Judy Fire Station, 5044 Maysville Road, Mt. Sterling
- Woodlands Industrial Park Fire Station, 225 Oak Grove Drive, Mt. Sterling
- Howard’s Mill First Church of God, 4267 Howard’s Mills Road, Mt. Sterling
- Hope Fire Station, 7750 Tapp Lane, Mt. Sterling
