Montgomery County High School has a student body that consists of approximately 1,300 students in grades 9-12. It is situated in the community of Mt. Sterling, Kentucky with a population of 7,166 and a county population of 288,157. There are four elementary schools and a single middle school that are providing students to our one high school. Montgomery County population includes 84.9% of high school graduate or higher education and 15.7% of a college bachelor degree or higher. The median income is \$45,516, persons below the poverty level is 15.8% as provided by the US Census Bureau. Mt. Sterling, KY, 30 miles east of Lexington, is the economic center of Montgomery County. Mt. Sterling's top industries include manufacturing, transportation and business services. Major employers range from Nestle, which makes its Hot Pocket and Lean Pocket products in Mt. Sterling, to automotive part suppliers. Mt. Sterling's quality of life attractions include golf, a regional arts center, a new hospital and a satellite campus for Morehead State University. Mt. Sterling/Montgomery County, a four-time 100 Best Community winner, was honored for its programs that offer young people service opportunities, access to extracurricular activities and a supportive educational environment. Giving back and serving the community is another priority for Mt. Sterling/Montgomery County. Our high school has multiple extra-curricular activities that serve our community. Those include athletic teams, Future Business Leaders of America, Future Farmers of America, KYA, KUNA, Big Brothers/Big Sisters, Play Pals, SERVE, Beta Club, Key Club and various other student activities.
